



## **Stroll For a Cause Rules and Regulations**

Although this is a strolling show involving college students on a college campus, it is still a *family* event. The rules provided are to ensure that not only the performers, but also those who attend with them (brothers, sisters, etc.) are helping to keep a family-friendly environment. Failure to abide by these rules may lead to a deduction of score, disqualification without a refund, or being asked to leave the premises.

- 1) ALL teams must have a *minimum of 4 performers and maximum of 6 performers*. Only 4-6 names may be submitted for final team roster. Due to the size of the stage, we ask to limit performers as a safety precaution.
- 2) Names of the performers must be submitted by the *due date September 17*. Any performer whose name is not on the list will not be able to perform. If changes are to be made in the list, a minimum of a week's notice is required. Failure to do so will result in a \$10 fine.
- **3)** Performers do not pay admission, only the performance fee. Performers will be checked upon arrival. PHOTO ID is required.
- 4) All performers, and guests, must be sober. As stated above, this is a family event. Any performer found under the influence will result in disqualification without a refund. Guests under the influence will be asked to leave.
- 5) Performances must be at least 2/3 STROLLING. Teams have 4 minutes to perform including on and off stage time. Therefore, at least *3 out of 4 minutes must be spent strolling*. Stepping and saluting is not allowed and will result in a *2-point deduction in score*.
- 6) Cancelling your performance without a notice in advance will result in a cancellation fee.
  Cancellation *any time from September 20 October 15* will result in a \$30 cancellation fee.
  Any time from October 16 to the day of the show will result in a \$50 cancellation fee.
- Clean music for the performance must be sent in by the *due date October 15*. Failure to send in music on time will result in a *\$10 fine*. Music and/or music changes will not be accepted after October 24.
- 8) Performers must refrain from inappropriate clothing or extremely provocative choreography.
  Please remember, this is a family event and children do attend. Failure to do so will result in a 2-point deduction in score.
- **9)** Failure to pay off any fees or fines will result in your organization's future participation to be reconsidered in the following Stroll for Cause competitions.
